Oracle Hyperion Planning Administration

The Oracle Hyperion Planning Administrator training is designed to guide students through the typical steps to build and administer on-premise Planning applications. Students develop and deploy Planning as an interactive case study over the duration of the course. After a general overview of Planning and Essbase, the course focuses on creating applications and currencies, followed by sections on Forms and Task Lists. Smart View is covered extensively, followed by maintaining security, the approval process and lifecycle management. Students learn about Financial reporting, creating basic reports, books and batches.
